



Downloading Digital stamps

1. Add the desired images to your shopping cart. You can add both physical merchandise and digital downloads to the cart at the same time.
2. Go through the checkout process entering your personal information (sorry – the cart program does need an address even if you are only getting digital downloads).
3. Choose your payment preference. If you do not have a PayPal account and would like to pay by credit card, choose PayPal anyway. On the PayPal payment page, there is an option for paying without an account. Choose that and you can enter your credit card info directly into a secure server. Note- if you only have free digital downloads, you will not be taken to a payment page (since you owe nothing).
4. Once you complete the transaction, you will receive a receipt with clickable download keys that will take you to your files for an instant download (you will also receive an e-mail for future reference).
5. Click the download key ONCE. (If you double click, you will sometimes receive a corrupted file because the program is trying to download the file twice at the same time).
6. In the window, choose where you want the file to be saved and click “save file”. You will receive a zipped file folder with all of the images inside.
7. Navigate to where the files are saved and RIGHT click on the saved zipped file. Choose “extract all”. If you have any difficulty unzipping, try downloading the file again (being sure to click the download key only once). Sometimes the files don't download correctly if the site is especially busy. We are working on this with our web host, but sometimes waiting a few minutes before trying again solves the problem. 8. Open the unzipped file – you should see all the images.

Using your digital images:

Digital images can be resized, combined, rotated and flipped in a variety of computer programs. Once the image is positioned as desired, simply print the image on cardstock and color. You may need to experiment with coloring mediums, paper and printer ink to prevent any ink smearing. We have had success with Neenah Classic Crest and Copic Markers with several different printers (Brother, HP, Epson) and a variety of inks (both name brand and generic).

You can copy the desired image to your computer's clipboard by RIGHT clicking on the file and scrolling down the dialog box to choose copy. Then open your desired program and use the paste function (or ctrl V) to paste the image into the program. You can also open the program and insert it.

In Microsoft Word:

Copy the image to the clipboard as above and paste into the document. Or insert it directly.

1. Open a Word document. Place the cursor where you want the image.
2. At the top, choose Insert. Then choose picture.
3. Navigate to your saved image then click OK.
4. You can resize and rotate the image using the format menu, or by using the corner of the drag box on the image.

In Microsoft Works:

1. Click on the insert link at the top of the menu.
2. Then click on picture, and then select the "from file". Navigate to the file.
3. Use the frame around the image to resize.

In Photoshop Elements:

1. Open the image in Photoshop.
2. At the top of the menu bar select the image link, then image resize, then resize.
3. Resize the image by entering in the dimension you need in the boxes. Click ok.
